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1. General overview of KharonBridge

KharonBridge is a private digital platform dedicated to personal writing, memory and transmission. It is built on one core logic: write, preserve, transmit over time.

The platform is structured around two distinct spaces, each addressing different uses and temporalities.

Le Carnet - main product

A private space to preserve what matters, before it disappears.

Le Carnet is the central product of KharonBridge. It allows each user to capture, organise, retrieve and transmit what matters over time: ideas, decisions, projects, reflections, personal notes and time capsules.

Le Carnet is not a classical digital diary, nor a productivity tool. It is a private space designed so that what matters today still exists tomorrow, and can be found, continued or transmitted.

Write to a Loved One - specialised vertical

This space is intended for people facing the loss of a loved one. It allows users to create an intimate environment in which they can write personal letters to a deceased relative, within a strictly private framework, with no public exposure and no social networking logic.

This space retains the founding emotional legitimacy of the project. It is not communicated as the main public-facing product, but is addressed specifically through psychologists, grief support associations and specialised practitioners.

Shared principles

- Confidentiality by default - no public content, no social network logic.
- Full user control over content, its organisation and its transmission.
- Absolute neutrality on religious, ideological and therapeutic matters.
- No interpretation of content - the platform provides a framework, not a discourse.

KharonBridge is not a social network, a medical, psychological or religious service, and is not intended to replace professional support.

2. The need addressed

The digital transformation of everyday life has profoundly changed the way individuals preserve and transmit their memories. Photos, messages, documents and personal exchanges are now predominantly produced and stored in digital form, often in a fragmented and unstructured manner.

In this context, two distinct needs remain insufficiently addressed by existing tools.

The need for private writing and personal transmission

Every day, important ideas, key decisions and significant reflections are lost in the digital noise. Existing tools do not meet this need: social networks expose, note-taking apps scatter, messaging apps disappear in the feed. No tool preserves or transmits over time with intention.

The need for grief support in a private framework

For people experiencing grief, the absence of an appropriate framework can make it difficult to preserve memories in an intimate, respectful and stable space, away from public exposure or external judgment. Social networks were not designed for this purpose. Existing memorial platforms remain static and impersonal.

Shared fundamental expectations

- Confidentiality of content, with no public dissemination by default.
- Data durability, beyond instant usage or social platforms.
- User control, over both access and the organisation and transmission of content.
- System neutrality, imposing no religious, therapeutic or ideological orientation.

KharonBridge addresses this need by offering a structured digital framework, specifically designed to meet these expectations, where existing solutions remain unsuitable or insufficient.

3. The solution offered

KharonBridge provides a structured response to the need for preserving and transmitting personal memory by offering a digital platform specifically designed for sensitive uses, where existing tools remain general-purpose, fragmented or unsuitable.

A platform designed for private and controlled use

KharonBridge allows users to centralise their content within a single, secure and durable environment. Texts, personal letters, documents and time capsules can be organised coherently, with no public exposure by default and no social visibility logic. Access to content is strictly controlled by the user.

A differentiated response based on user intent

Le Carnet addresses the daily need for private writing and transmission: ideas, decisions, projects, reflections and time capsules. It is designed for anyone who wants a durable space for what matters, away from digital noise.

The Write to a Loved One space addresses the specific need of grief: writing to a deceased loved one within a private, symbolic framework. It is addressed through psychologists and specialised associations, following a human prescriber logic rather than mass-market communication.

Technology in service of meaning

KharonBridge integrates advanced digital features in a deliberately restrained manner. Technology is used as a support, not an end in itself. Any automated assistance offered by the platform operates within an informative or symbolic framework, without prescriptive or decision-making intent.

A progressive and respectful model

The solution is accessible online through a progressive model combining a free trial period and extended features available via subscription. This model allows simple discovery of the platform while guaranteeing, at all levels of use, the confidentiality, ownership and user control of content.

4. Ethical positioning and compliance

From its inception, KharonBridge has been designed around a strict ethical framework, taking into account the sensitivity of uses related to personal memory, grief and the transmission of intimate messages. The platform adopts a deliberately responsible posture, aimed at protecting users, their content and their freedom of expression.

Neutrality and system responsibility

KharonBridge is built on a fundamental principle of tool neutrality. The platform imposes no religious, spiritual, ideological or therapeutic orientation and provides no interpretation of the content created by users.

This neutrality does not limit personal expression: each user remains fully free to incorporate, within their private space, the symbols, beliefs or references that are meaningful to them. Responsibility for meaning and content lies exclusively with the user.

Confidentiality and user control

Confidentiality is a central pillar of the platform. Spaces created on KharonBridge are private by default and are not subject to any public dissemination. Access to content is strictly controlled by the user, who freely defines the individuals authorised to view or receive specific elements.

Data protection and regulatory compliance

KharonBridge applies a privacy by design data protection approach, in compliance with the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Data collection is limited to what is strictly necessary for the operation of the service.

Personal data and emotionally sensitive content are neither used for advertising purposes nor transferred to third parties. Users benefit from rights of access, rectification and deletion of their data.

Responsible use of technology

Technologies integrated into KharonBridge are implemented to serve the user experience without encouraging dependency, influence or over-interpretation. Any automated assistance offered operates within an informative or symbolic framework, without prescriptive or decision-making intent, and without replacing professional support.

KharonBridge is built on one simple principle: provide a space, without interpreting what is written in it. Meaning belongs to the person.

5. Business model

KharonBridge is built on a progressive business model, designed to balance accessibility, service sustainability and respect for the sensitive nature of personal memory use cases.

Model principles

- No advertising within the platform.
- No commercial exploitation of personal content.
- No transfer of personal data to third parties.
- Value is created exclusively through the service provided to users.

KharonBridge's business model is designed to remain aligned with its ethical commitments. The subscription ensures the technical continuity of the platform and the security of data, without recourse to advertising mechanisms or the monetisation of user data.

6. About the founder

Fabrice Ortovent

KharonBridge is led by its founder, Fabrice Ortovent, an entrepreneur and consultant who has been involved for several years in projects combining structuring, technology and reflection on digital uses.

His professional background has been shaped by the creation and support of entrepreneurial structures, primarily in international contexts, with particular attention given to the sustainability of business models, legal compliance and the responsible use of digital tools.

Project origin

KharonBridge was born from a personal need: to write to his late father, in a private space, without a social network, without exposure. That first intuition gave birth to the Write to a Loved One space. Over time, product thinking showed that the need extended beyond grief alone, and Le Carnet was born.

Current stage

The entire technical foundation has been designed and delivered by the founder: the kharonbridge.com website, the Le Carnet PWA, the Write to a Loved One spaces (web and PWA), public pricing and an onboarding sequence in French and English. An iOS application is currently in development.

In developing KharonBridge, particular importance is placed on the separation between the tool and interpretation: the platform provides a framework but conveys no normative discourse regarding content, beliefs or user choices.
