01 / WHY WE EXIST

Memory is more than recollection.

KharonBridge designs systems that preserve what deserves to endure, without taking away each person's control over the meaning they give it.

We live among saved content that has fallen silent: a note without its intention, a decision without its circumstances, a memory without the relationship that once gave it meaning.

KharonBridge has a simple mission, and an exacting one: to preserve what matters together with the context that makes it useful again once time has passed.

OUR FOUNDING QUESTION

How do we preserve what matters as time passes?

This question runs through every product: personal memory, professional memory, relational memory and transmission.

KharonBridge is not building another archive. It is building a territory: private, contextual and retrievable memory.

Useful memory must be able to remain, return and illuminate.

Keeping something is not enough. You must also be able to recover what made an idea, decision or memory meaningful.

03 / THE SYSTEMS

Three products. One ambition.

KharonBridge is not developing three apps at the same pace or for the same purpose. Each product has a distinct role within a shared architecture.

PRIORITY 1

Le Carnet

The entry product: private personal memory, built to validate use, activation, retention and the consumer model.

PILLAR 2

Mnémosyne

The structured-memory laboratory: a rich professional environment where context, chronology, decisions and relationships between items are tested.

SPECIALISED VERTICAL

Writing to Someone You've Lost

A relational-memory and transmission space, deliberately designed with restraint to preserve an intimate bond.

Le Carnet makes personal memory accessible. Mnémosyne tests structured memory. Writing to Someone You've Lost extends this vision through a specialised relational vertical.

04 / PRIORITY PRODUCT

Le Carnet

A private space to write, clarify and rediscover what matters.

Le Carnet is a personal memory app. It gives people a place to keep ideas, decisions, reflections and moments worth finding again later.

Its value emerges over time: when an entry is revisited, resumed, enriched or placed back in context. Le Carnet is not a simple note-taking app. It offers a place where a thought can remain without disappearing into the stream.

USE

A private, understated personal memory

Open, closed or revisit-later entries; time capsules; delayed rereading. No social network, no public exposure, no pressure to return frequently.

ACCESS

Already available to the public

Freemium model. Personal subscription: €4.99/month. Time capsules are offered separately in packs.

Role within KharonBridge: the first commercial validation ground and the entry point into the territory of personal memory.

Mnémosyne

KharonBridge's structured-memory laboratory.

Mnémosyne is KharonBridge's professional and decision-memory system. It is designed for independent professionals, founders and teams who need to preserve projects, decisions, documents, exchanges and working rationale.

STRATEGIC ROLE

Building memory that connects

Mnémosyne tests mechanisms for context, chronology, relationships between items and retrieval. The most relevant mechanisms are intended to progressively enrich Le Carnet in a lighter form suited to personal use.

This is not a claim that a universal engine already exists. It is a deliberate trajectory: build, test and then adapt the memory capabilities that prove most relevant.

STATUS

A V1 used daily by the founder

The next step is to turn this internal use into a robust, clear product that can be tested with first professional users.

Writing to Someone You've Lost

A private space for preserving a bond and what deserves to be passed on.

Writing to Someone You've Lost offers an intimate setting for writing to someone who has died, keeping letters and leaving quiet words from the heart.

The product is not a substitute for therapy or medical support. It does not attempt to make the deceased speak. It leaves room for writing, memory and the continuity of a bond.

ORIGIN

KharonBridge's first gesture

This vertical raised the broader question at the origin of the company: what do we lose when there is no place to preserve what matters together with its context?

ACCESS

A deliberately contained experience

Two letters are available free of charge. Continued access is offered at €4.99/month. Quiet words remain free.

07 / CLARA

A memory assistant, deployed product by product.

Clara helps surface patterns, connections and context so people can rediscover what illuminates an idea, decision or memory.

Its role is not to decide meaning on the user's behalf. Clara makes no diagnosis and offers no definitive truth about a person. It makes continuities visible when the context warrants it.

IN LE CARNET

Surfacing patterns

Connecting saved ideas, reflections, decisions and moments; helping users rediscover what illuminates an entry.

IN MNÉMOSYNE

Testing denser memory

Working with the relationships between context, chronology, projects and decisions in a professional environment.

IN WRITING TO SOMEONE YOU'VE LOST

Staying within a strictly appropriate frame

An assistant deliberately bounded by the sensitive nature of relational memory.

Privacy is a product requirement.

KharonBridge systems hold personal, sometimes sensitive content. Trust cannot be an option added after the fact.

PRINCIPLE

Private by design

Content is designed to remain in a personal space, without social-network mechanics or public exposure.

PRINCIPLE

Control of meaning

KharonBridge imposes no religious, ideological or therapeutic framework. Users remain free to give their own meaning to what they keep.

PRINCIPLE

AI with limits

Clara can surface patterns, connections and continuities; it does not diagnose or decide on a person's behalf.

PRINCIPLE

An aligned business model

The product's value comes from the service it provides to the user, not from exploiting their intimacy.

09 / THE FOUNDER

Fabrice Ortovent

Entrepreneur and consultant in company structuring and international strategic decision-making.

His professional work has placed him in situations where continuity of information, clarity of decisions and the quality of context are decisive.

He designed KharonBridge's first assets: the platform, Le Carnet, Writing to Someone You've Lost and the first version of Mnémosyne. His role is to carry the doctrine, product architecture and coherence between the memory systems.

HIS ROLE

Keeping the company coherent

Vision, doctrine, product architecture and strategic decisions. The founder carries continuity between Le Carnet and Mnémosyne: structured memory first tested in work progressively enriches the personal experience.

KharonBridge began with a relational intuition. It has grown into a broader ambition: building systems able to preserve the ideas, decisions, relationships and contexts that deserve to endure.
